



To provide food and clothing for people in need through the generosity of our community.

Thank you for your interest in hosting a food/fund drive for the North Anoka County Emergency Foodshelf (NACE). With your help, NACE will continue to provide food, clothing and resources to the hungry people in our community. NACE distributes on average 14,000 pounds of food each month to 635 individuals. The Foodshelf strives to provide at least 3 meals a day for 4 days for each member of a person's family. To give you an idea of what that means, every pound donated equals roughly 1.3 meals.

NACE will use funds donated to continue our mission of providing food and clothing to people in need through the generosity of our community. Beyond donations of food, NACE spends \$2,500 each month on food purchases plus other programming and administrative costs.
